

**TOWN OF SIDNEY
NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT APPLICATION**

The Council of the Town of Sidney is considering the issuance of a Development Variance Permit for 10412 Resthaven Drive (*property shown below in Figure 1*). The proposed Development Variance Permit would vary the following sections of Town of Sidney bylaws:

Zoning Bylaw 2015	Bylaw Requirement	Proposed
Section 5.2.7.a.ii.: Maximum gross floor area of a secondary suite	90 m ²	120.1 m ²

The purpose of this Development Variance Permit is to retroactively allow for a secondary suite larger than the maximum size permitted by the Zoning Bylaw, in order to retain and formalize the existing secondary suite located within the single-family dwelling on the subject property.

The property affected by this application is:

The land that is subject to the variance is shown as hatched on the plan below:

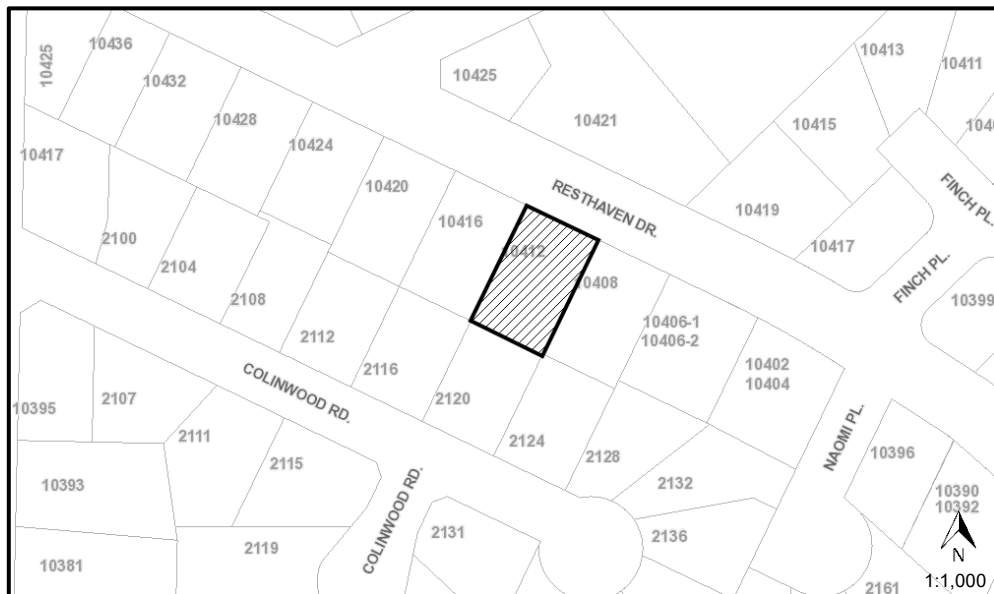
