

TOWN OF SIDNEY NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT APPLICATION

The Council of the Town of Sidney is considering the issuance of a Development Variance Permit for 2134 Brethourpark Way (*property shown below in Figure 1*). The proposed Development Variance Permit would vary the following sections of Town of Sidney bylaws:

Zoning Bylaw No. 2015	Required	Proposed
Section 5.1.12.a.ii.: Heat Pumps: Minimum setback from a lot line	3.0 m	0.8 m

The purpose of this Development Variance Permit is to allow for a reduced minimum permitted side yard setback for heat pumps to allow a heat pump within the interior side yard of the subject property.

The land that is subject to the variance is shown as hatched on the plan below:

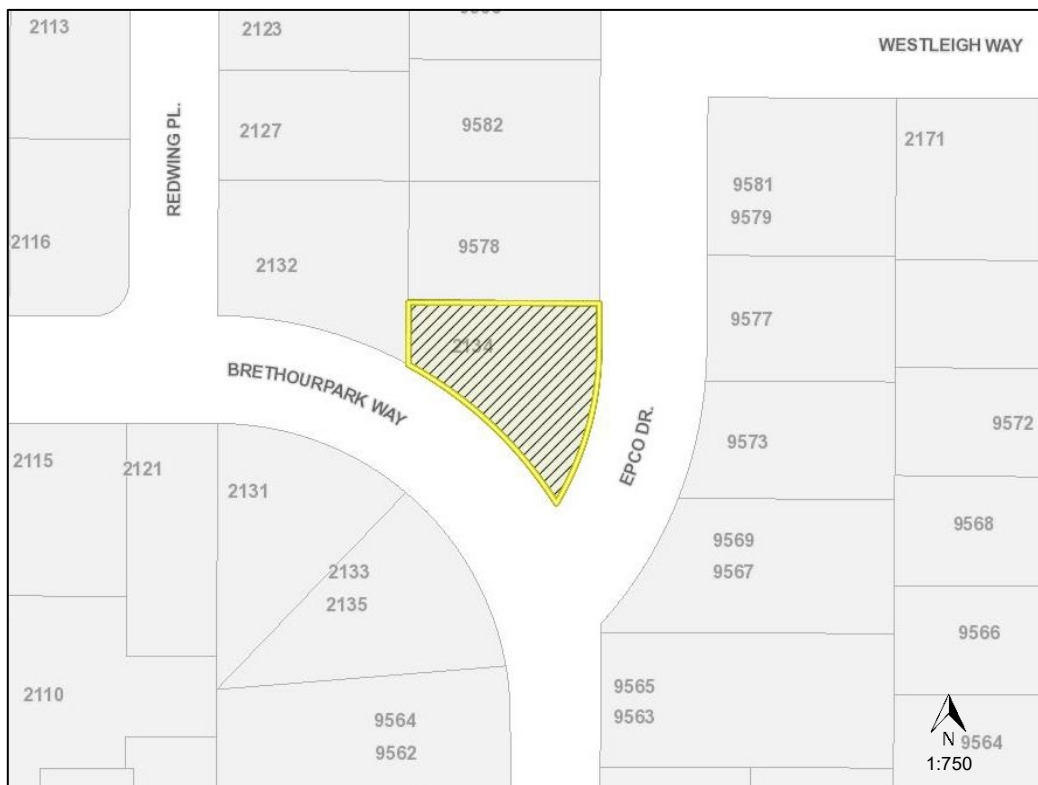
