

**TOWN OF SIDNEY
NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT APPLICATION**

The Council of the Town of Sidney is considering the issuance of a Development Variance Permit for 9490 Maryland Drive (property shown below in Figure 1). The proposed Development Variance Permit would vary the following section of Town of Sidney bylaws:

Zoning Bylaw 2015	Bylaw Requirement	Proposed
Section 5.2.2: Minimum Rear Yard Setback	5.50 m	5.34 m

The purpose of the above-referenced Development Variance Permit is to allow a newly constructed addition to the existing single-family dwelling on the subject property to remain within the minimum rear yard setback required by the Zoning Bylaw.

The land that is subject to the variance is shown as hatched on the plan below:

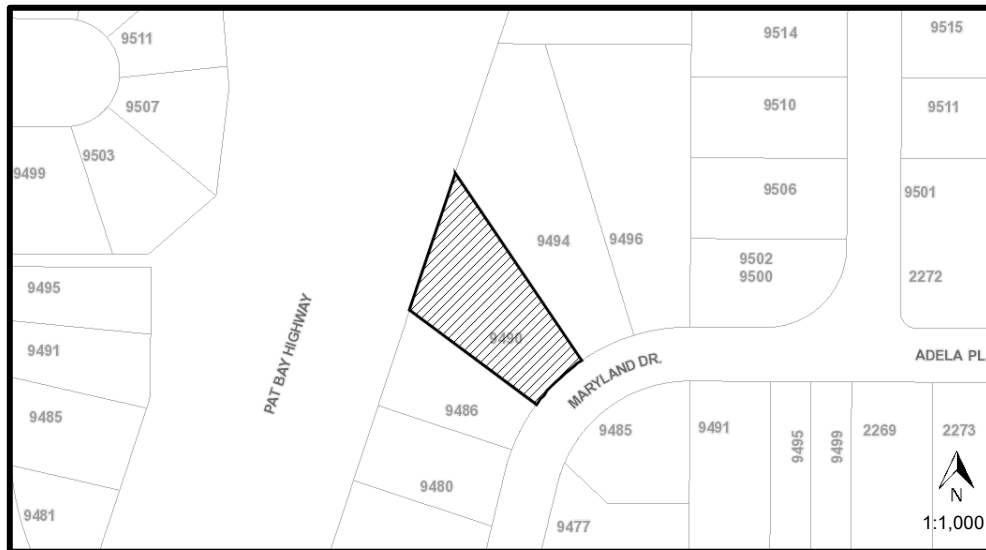
