### VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS

### VOTER REGISTRATION

Resident Electors and Non-Resident Property Electors who are not on the list of registered electors and who have not registered in advance may register on voting days.

**Resident electors** must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove both residency and identity.

**Non-Resident Property Electors** must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the other property owners. **This consent must be provided at time of registration.** (Forms are available at the respective Municipal Halls and websites).

The following are examples of acceptable identification: BC Driver's Licence, BC Identification Card, BC Care Card, utility bill (water, electrical gas), Social Insurance Card, Citizenship Card, Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Licence issued by ICBC, Property Taxation Notice, Credit Card or Debit Card issued by a bank.

### VOTE BY MAIL

All qualified electors may vote by mail ballot. Please complete an application form, available at the respective Municipal Halls and websites, and return it to the municipality. Mail ballot packages will be sent out commencing on or about September 26, 2022. **Important: To be counted, your completed mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 4:00pm on Friday, October 14, 2022 at the respective Municipal Halls, or no later than 8:00pm on Saturday, October 15, 2022 at the location directed in your mail ballot package instructions.**
