SIDNEY TAKES THE LEAD in Royal Wedding celebrations. On April 29th His Royal Highness Prince William of Wales will marry Miss Catherine Middleton and we want to commemorate this occasion. On Friday, February 18th at 11:00 am at the Town Clock in front of the Historical Museum on Beacon Avenue, Mayor Larry Cross will be joined by Town Crier, Kenny Podmore, to proclaim the week of April 24th to 30th the Royal Wedding Week. During this special week, all Sidney businesses will be encouraged to decorate in a royal red, white and blue theme in honour of the nuptials.

In London the wedding venue will be Westminster Abbey – in Sidney the Mary Winspear Community Centre will be the place to celebrate this happy and momentous occasion. A Royal Wedding Breakfast, which will serve food that is “second to none”, will take place on April 29th at 9:00 am. Those attending are encouraged to dress in royal wedding fashion and during the breakfast a recording of the special ceremony will be shown.

Mayor Cross thanked Councillor Podmore for arranging this celebration and also noted “Sidney is not able to declare a public holiday in honour of the wedding, however, we know how to throw a party and are absolutely delighted that we can hold this celebration which will give everyone a chance to enjoy the big day”.
