

Town of Sidney NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Bylaw No. 2174 (Cannabis)

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Sidney will hold a Public Hearing in respect of Bylaw No. 2174, being a proposed amendment to Zoning Bylaw No. 2015 for the Town of Sidney.

The purpose of Bylaw No. 2174 is to add regulations to the Zoning Bylaw that would allow the retail sale of cannabis products in parts of Sidney's Downtown Commercial (C1) zone. The bylaw would also permit the processing and manufacturing of cannabis products in Sidney's Industrial (M1) zone in the Sidney Business Park.

All persons who believe that their property is affected by the proposed amending bylaw will be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting matters contained in the bylaw at the Public Hearing to be held at the Sidney Town Hall, 2440 Sidney Avenue, Sidney, BC on **Monday, August 12, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.** Written submissions can be received at the Town Hall prior to 4:00 p.m. on August 12, 2019 or at the Public Hearing itself.

Copies of the proposed bylaw, as well as all background documentation, may be inspected during normal working hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays) from **July 8, 2019 to August 12, 2019** at Sidney Town Hall, 2440 Sidney Avenue, Sidney, BC, V8L 1Y7.
