SNOW CLEARING

In the event of a snowfall, the Town of Sidney will assign a high priority to clearing major arterial and collector streets and will also clear snow and ice from as many local streets as possible. In addition, snow and ice will be cleared from the sidewalks at major intersections and bus stops, with the highest priority given to locations serving higher pedestrian volumes.

Residents, property owners and businesses are reminded that Section 51 of the Town's Streets and Traffic Regulation Bylaw No. 1966 requires every resident to clear snow and ice from the sidewalk in front of or abutting their property.

The Town is therefore requesting co-operation from all residents in this matter to ensure the safety and convenience of the public at large. Please remember your elderly or disabled neighbours who need your assistance. Your efforts to make Sidney a safer all-weather community are greatly appreciated.
