1. **Dignity of the Flag** - The National Flag of Canada should be displayed only in a manner befitting this important national symbol and should not be subjected to indignity or displayed in a position inferior to any other flag. The flag symbolizes the nation’s unity and the honour and pride of all citizens and should be treated with respect.
2. **Displaying Flags** - The manner in which flags will be displayed on public flag poles within the Town, including half-mast positioning, will be as per the rules outlined by the Federal Government (www.pch.gc.ca).
