NOTICE OF LIQUOR LICENCE APPLICATION

The Cut Cartel Barber Shop (Unit C - 2425 Bevan Avenue) has applied to the BC Liquor & Cannabis Regulation Branch (LCRB) for a "liquor primary" licence to allow for the serving of alcohol during their hours of barbering services, which are Monday to Saturday from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Sidney Town Council will be responding to the LCRB's referral with a recommendation regarding this application and as part of this process will consider comments from the public (*property shown below in Figure 1*).

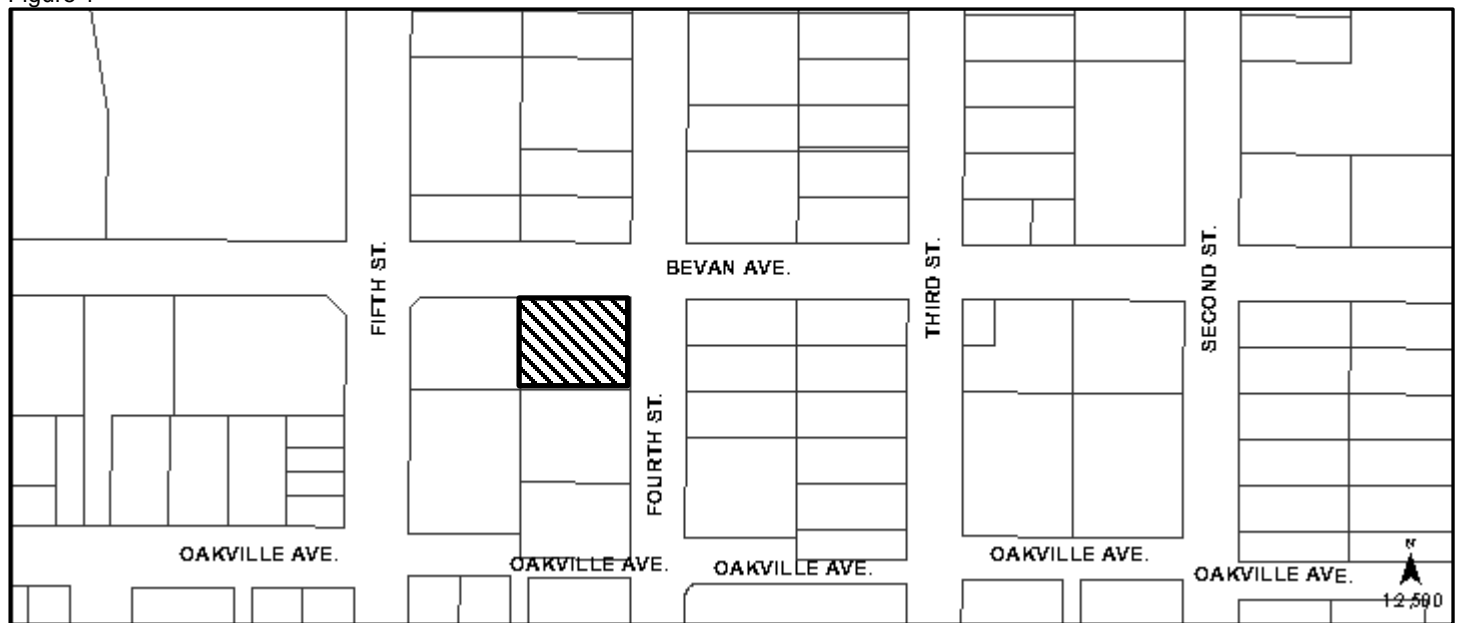
