TOWN OF SIDNEY NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT APPLICATION

The purpose of the above referenced Development Variance Permit is to 1) legalize the siting of an accessory structure under construction within the minimum permitted setback for structures adjacent to Highway 17; and 2) increase the maximum area of a home occupation within the same accessory structure from 35 m2 (376 ft2) to 44 m2 (474 ft2).


