Notice is given that Sidney Council will be considering the approval of Development Variance Permit Application No. DV100395 for 10007 Siddall Road (*property shown below*) at a Council meeting held in the **Sidney Town Hall Council Chambers, 2440 Sidney Avenue, Sidney, BC, V8L 1Y7**, on **Monday, September 28, 2026**, at **6:00 p.m.** The proposed Development Variance Permit would vary the following sections of Town of Sidney bylaw:

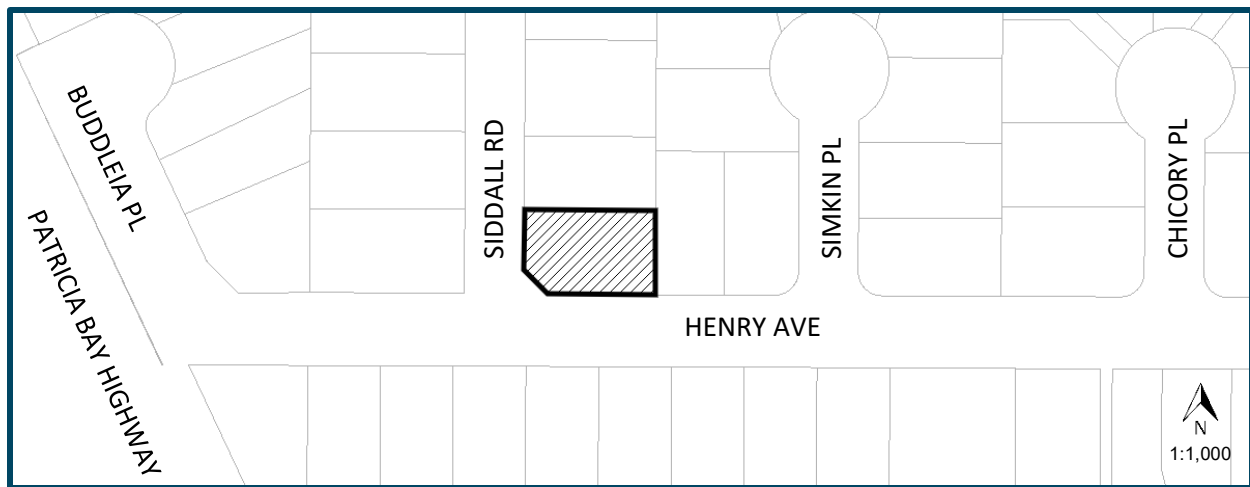
Zoning Bylaw No. 2275	Bylaw Requirement	Proposed
Section 5.2.2: Minimum Rear Setback	4.5 m	3 m
Section 5.2.2: Minimum Interior Side Setback	2.0 m	1.5 m
Section 5.2.2: Minimum Exterior Side Setback	3.0 m	1.5 m

The purpose of this Development Variance Permit is to relax the minimum rear, interior side, and exterior side setbacks in order to site a residential dwelling in the rear yard of the subject property.
