- 1. Parks staff shall:
 - a. Undertake an annual pruning of all sidewalk areas within the Town of Sidney.
 - b. Attend promptly to correct obstructions to traffic signs, sitelines or other obvious hazards.
- 2. The homeowner is responsible for keeping the sidewalk clear of vegetation and for snow and ice removal (Note: Responsibility for removal of snow and ice is by bylaw.) In order to ensure vegetation clearing is done, the Town will adopt a system which is similar to the one which addresses weed complaints. This allows for cost recovery.
- Note: Resthaven Drive and Third Street represent two of Sidney's busiest pedestrian walks and account for a large proportion of complaints. These streets and adjoining sidewalks are separated by a Town boulevard. Any obstructing trees or shrubs, if not directly on the boulevard are the property of the homeowner.

Response to Complaints

- 1. All requests or complaints will be referred directly to the Director/Manager responsible.
- 2. Determination of referral will be the responsibility of the Chief Administrative Officer.
- 3. The matter will be referred to Council only if the complainant remains dissatisfied.
